## Get Involved in Improving Transportation in Corvallis: The Transportation System Plan & Transit Development Plan

The way we travel to school, work and activities is an essential part of each day — whether it's on foot, in a car, on a bike or skateboard, or riding on a bus. Having people get where they need to go safely and efficiently is a top priority for the City of Corvallis. A process is underway to plan for our community's transportation needs as the area grows.

The City is currently updating its Transportation System Plan (TSP), which was adopted in 1996. The new TSP will guide City transportation projects and programs over the next 20 years. The City is also creating a new Transit Development Plan that will guide expansion and improvements to the Corvallis Transit System.

### Project Update

The project has achieved many milestones since kick-off. A project Steering Committee was formed to provide a community perspective to the process of developing the plans. Their meetings are open to the public. A city-wide survey gathered information from people living and working in Corvallis about the TSP update goals. The team used that input as draft goals and objectives were refined. Current project goals include:

- Providing an efficient transportation system that supports economic vitality by facilitating the local and regional movement of people and goods.
- Providing a transportation system that enhances the health and safety of residents.
- Providing a diversified and accessible transportation system that ensures mobility for all members of the community and provides viable alternatives to automobile travel.
- Providing a sustainable transportation system through responsible stewardship of financial and environmental resources.

Most recently, a series of memos were prepared identifying transportation challenges and opportunities. You can download these project documents at [CorvallisTSP.org/library](http://CorvallisTSP.org/library). The project team will share the results of these memos at the November 29th open house.

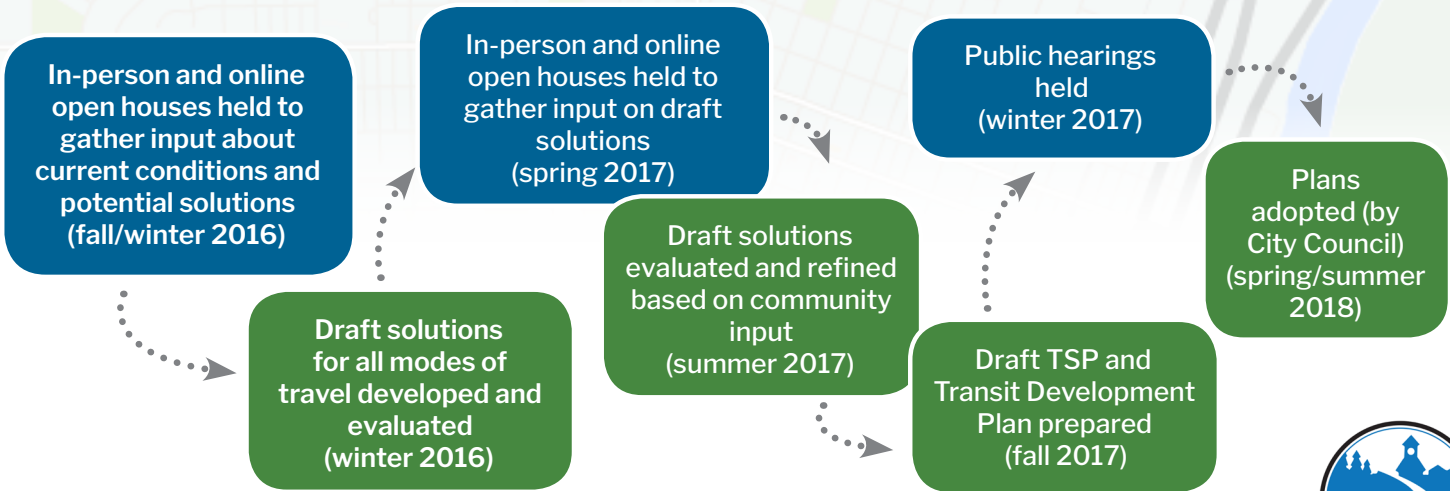
